- Opportunity to grow your company in the Rensselaer Incubator Program

New program terms:

- Student or company pays provisional patent cost and worldwide licensing fee (total= \$435)
- Student or student's company is responsible for patent prosecution and costs
- No minimum annual fees are payable to RPI
- No royalties are payable to RPI until company reaches annual gross sales of \$1,000,000 or more! Then a 1% royalty on gross sales is due RPI
